ORDINANCE NO #2022-06

ORDINANCE RESCINDING THE PRIOR ORDINANCE 8.12.14C PROVIDING FOR THE
LICENSING AND CONTROLLING OF CATS IN THE TOWNSHIP OF SHREWSBURY,
MONMOUTH COUNTY, NEW JERSEY

WHEREAS, Shrewsbury Township is a public municipality and can create, amend, or rescind Ordinances that it feels is in the public interest; and

WHEREAS, on August 12, 2014 the Shrewsbury Township Committee adopted an Ordinance requiring the licensing of all cats kept by any person, business, corporation, or association at more than six months of age, on an annual basis, for which the Township Committee now feels does not serve its purpose and is economically burdensome to the Township.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED, by the Mayor and Township Committee of the Township of Shrewsbury in the County of Monmouth and the State of New Jersey, as follows:

1. Ordinance 8/12/14C, providing for the licensing and controlling of cats in the Township of Shrewsbury, Monmouth County, New Jersey shall hereby be repealed and rescinded.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED AND ENACTED, that this Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon final adoption and public hearing in the manner prescribed by law.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED AND ENACTED, that all Ordinances or parts of Ordinances that are inconsistent herewith are repealed, but only to the extent of such inconsistency.

This Ordinance shall be effective upon passage and publication as required by law.
