The mission of our school counseling program is to support all students through a comprehensive and developmental approach by addressing academic, career, personal/social skills necessary to achieve quality learning and lifelong success as directed by the Monmouth Regional School District and the New Jersey Department of Education.

Monmouth Regional offers a competitive curriculum including college preparatory courses to honors and advanced placement courses. We offer 22 Advanced Placement courses and also a four year gifted and talented program, the AP Academy, offered to select incoming freshman.

Graduation Requirements Include:

- 4 years of English/PE & Health
- 3 years of Math
- 3 years of Science
- 2 years of United States History
- 1 year of World History
- 1 year of World Language
- 1 year of a Practical Art
- 1 year of a Visual/Performing Art
- 1/2 year of Financial Literacy
- 120 Total Credits
- Proficiency on current State Testing

Colleges will look to make sure that your child has a competitive transcript which will include additional years of the above mentioned courses. For instance, even though at the end of junior year your child has satisfied math, science and history requirements, we will always encourage a 4th year of academic courses. In addition, most colleges require a minimum of two years of the same world language. Although college is still many years away for all of you, it will be here before you know it! Your school counselor will help you map out the road to your future!
